


3-2. ORNAMENT SECTION




Note 1: When removing the lithium ion storage battery (Ref. No. BAT1), the lithium ion storage battery cannot be reused. Be sure to replace it with a new part. When replacing the lithium ion storage battery, refer to “CHECKING THE NEW LITHIUM ION STORAGE BATTERY FOR BEFORE USE AND NOTES ON HANDLING” on page 4. Also, there are two types of the lithium ion storage battery for except CH, but the repair parts of the lithium ion storage battery is one type. For details, refer to “ABOUT THE TYPE OF THE LITHIUM ION STORAGE BATTERY (Except CH)” on page 4.

Note 2: When removing the cushion (BATT) (Ref. No. 51) and NTC thermistor (Ref. No. TH1) from the lithium ion storage battery, be careful so that the lithium ion storage battery is never damaged.

Note 3: When removing the ornament (L) assy (Ref. No. DMIC1) and installing it, be sure to refer to “CHECKING METHOD AFTER INSTALLING THE ORNAMENT (L) ASSY” on page 8.

3-4. HEADBAND SECTION



Note 1: Lubricant (SANKOL) is applied to the sub cushion AORI assy (Ref. No. 151). Be careful when handling the parts.


Note 2: Lubricant (SANKOL) is applied to the inner side of slider lower (L) assy (Ref. No. 153) and slider lower (R) assy (Ref. No. 154). Be careful when handling so that you do not touch the portion applied with the lubricant (SANKOL). For the application location of the lubricant (SANKOL), refer to “NOTES ON HANDLING OF SLIDER LOWER (L) ASSY AND SLIDER LOWER (R) ASSY BY LUBRICANT APPLICATION” on page 5.
